Sub: ESIC Pensioners Medical Scheme – rates of contribution.

Sir,

Consequent upon implementation of the report of the 6th Pay Commission and revision of pay scales and pension, the matter regarding finalization of the subscriptions for enrolment under the ESIC-PMS-2006 was under examination of this office. The CGHS have also revised the rates of subscription applicable to the Central Govt. employees and pensioner. Since the ESIC-PMS is based on the CGHS rules and the rates of subscription and entitlements in respect of ESIC-PMS were also similar to those applicable to CGHS beneficiaries, it has been decided to revise the rates of contribution, entitlement of wards etc. of pensioners under ESIC-PMS-2006 at par with CGHS pensioners. Accordingly, in supersession to all earlier instructions on the subject, the following revisions are being made, in so far as it relates to the facilities mentioned below:-

(A) Monthly Contributions for availing ESIC facility by ESIC Pensioners:

S.No.	Grade pay drawn by the pensioners	Contribution (Rupees per month)
1	Upto Rs. 1,650/- per month	50/-

(B) Entitlement of wards in private hospitals empanelled under ESIC:

**(C) Pay slab for determining the entitlement of accommodation in AIIMS,
New Delhi:**

S.No.	Pay (in the pay band)/Pension/Family Pension drawn per month	Ward entitlement
1	Upto Rs. 19,530/-	General Ward
2	From Rs. 19,540/- to Rs. 25,110/-	Private Ward
3	Rs. 25,120/- and above	Private Ward/ Deluxe Ward

2) Reference to pay in this order relates to the pay drawn in the pay band.

3) Pensioners have an option to get their ESIC medical card made by either making contribution on an annual basis (twelve months) or by making contribution for 10 (ten) years [120 (one hundred and twenty months)] for getting a pensioners card with life-time validity.

Pensioner beneficiaries, who have already obtained ESIC card with life time validity by paying a lump sum amount equivalent to 10 years' contribution, will not be required to pay any additional amount as a result of the revision in the rates of contribution for availing ESIC facility. Entitlement of pensioners/family pensioners who have already deposited their contribution for life time ESIC facility, will not be changed.

Pensioners/family pensioners who are contributing to the ESIC on an annual basis and wish to continue to avail benefits under the Scheme will have to contribute at the revised rates upto the time of contribution needed to cover a period of a total of ten years from the time pensioner ESIC card was issued for the first time to them. The revised rate of contribution for the remaining period would be with reference to the grade pay that he/she would have drawn in the post held by him/her (at the time of his/her retirement/death) had he/she continued to be in service now but for his/ her retirement/ death.

This issues with the approval of Director General in concurrence with the Financial Commissioner.
